

## Uniform Requirements for Troop 66

### **Bold is required:**

1. **Khaki shirt i.e. Class “A” uniform**
  - **comes with US flag**
2. Left Sleeve
  - **Des Plaines Valley Council patch**
  - “70” years old (optional) “75” in 8/1/09!
  - **“66” for sleeve (2 “6” patches)**
  - Troop position (usually after scout earns 1<sup>st</sup> class)
  - “Trained” – earned after Jr. Leader Training course
3. Right Sleeve
  - Quality Unit 2007 AND PROUD OF IT!
  - **Patrol patch (TBD)**
4. **Boy Scout emblem slide**
5. **Red neckerchief with royal blue stitching**
6. Universal Scouting emblem (purple with white fleur-de-lis)
7. **Red shoulder loops**
8. Arrow of Light patch (if earned) below left pocket
9. Religious knot (if earned) centered above left pocket
10. **Boy Scout Handbook** – considered part of uniform so it should be brought to meetings and campouts! Placement of patches can be found in the handbook.

A class “B” t-shirt can be worn for campouts and service projects. A t-shirt with a fleur-de-lis is considered a Class “B” uniform.
